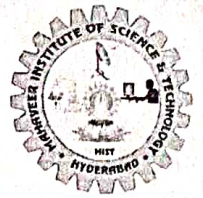

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NATIONAL EDUCATION POLICY -2020 [REPORT]

The Mahaveer Institute of Science & Technology, Hyderabad conducted the webinar on “National Education Policy(NEP-2020)” on 24.03.2021, 3pm through the “Google Meet” web platform. The Head of dept’s, faculty members and students of various dept of Engg’s, Humanities & Science and Management participated in Webinar. The webinar organized by **Dr. A. Nanadagopal Reddy**, Professor & Head, Dept. of IT with systematic agenda.

The webinar conducted by eminent professors with good background on the education system. They delivered the topic in more understandable and informative manner. The brief report of the webinar is as follows.

Speaker-1 :

Dr. B.Nageshwara Rao, Principal, Mahaveer Institute of Science & Technology focused on the role and importance of the education in human life. He illustrated the historical perspective of education system in India and its amendments.

Education is a weapon to improve the human life. Education of a child begins at home and it is lifelong process until end of death. Education determines individual quality life which improves one’s knowledge, skills and develops the personality and attitude.

Speaker-2 :

Dr. J.Malla Reddy, Professor & Officer on Special Duty, Mahaveer Educational Society delivered the content on importance of National Education Policy-2020 and its advantages over the NPE-1986 . The speaker highlighted the various up gradations of school education system in NEP-2020 is as follows.

- New Policy aims the education from pre-school to secondary level with 100 % Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in school education by 2030.
- NEP 2020 will bring 2 crores out of school children back to mainstream with open schooling system.
- The current 10+2 system to be replaced by a new 5+3+3+4 curricular structure corresponding to ages 3-8, 8-11, 11-14, and 14-18 years respectively. The new system will have 12 years of schooling with three years of Anganwadi/ pre-schooling.
- Emphasis on Foundational Literacy and Numeracy, no rigid separation between academic streams, extracurricular, vocational streams in schools; Vocational Education to start from Class 6 with Internships.
- Teaching up to at least Grade 5 to be with mother tongue/ regional language, there is no language compulsion.
- Assessment reforms with 360-degree Holistic Progress Card, tracking Student Progress for achieving Learning Outcomes



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Speaker-3.

Dr. V. Gunashekar Reddy, Professor & Director(R&D), Mahaveer Institute of Science & Technology specially focused on higher education system in the National Education Policy in 2020 with the following.

- Gross Enrolment Ratio in higher education to be raised to 50 % by 2035.
- The policy envisages broad-based, multi-disciplinary, holistic Under Graduate education with flexible curricula, creative combinations of subjects, integration of vocational education, and multiple entries and exit points with appropriate certification. UG education can be of 3 or 4 years with multiple exit options and appropriate certification within this period.
- Academic Bank of Credits to be established to facilitate Transfer of Credits
- Multidisciplinary Education and Research Universities (MERUs), at par with IITs, IIMs, to be set up as models of best multidisciplinary education of global standards in the country.
- The National Research Foundation will be created as an apex body for fostering a strong research culture and building research capacity across higher education.
- Higher Education Commission of India (HECI) will be set up as a single overarching umbrella body for entire higher education. HECI to have four independent subsystems – 1. National Higher Education Regulatory Council (NHERC) for regulation 2. General Education Council (GEC) for standard-setting. 3. Higher Education Grants Council (HEGC) for funding 4.National Accreditation Council(NAC) for accreditation. The higher education institutions will be governed by the same set of norms for regulation, accreditation, and academic standards.
- An autonomous body, the National Educational Technology Forum (NETF), will be created to provide a platform for the free exchange of ideas on the use of technology to enhance learning, assessment, planning, administration.
- NEP 2020 emphasizes setting up of Gender Inclusion Fund, Special Education Zones for disadvantaged regions and groups.
- The Centre and the States will work together to increase the public investment in the Education sector to reach 6% of GDP at the earliest.
