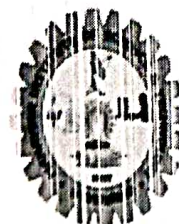

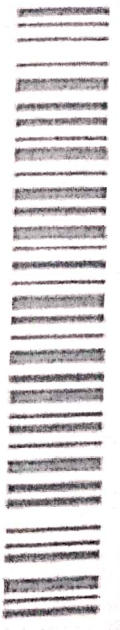

2) Prepare all the documents required by the Italian Embassy

Documents required by the Embassy:

1. two copies of your pre-enrollment application form;
2. two passport-sized photographs, one of which must be signed by you;
3. the University degree certificate or educational qualification certificate which allows you to access to 2<sup>nd</sup> cycle degree programs. This must have already been legalized by the competent Authority of the country which issued it, with Apostille stamp, and officially translated into Italian;
4. official certificate issued by the foreign academic institution with the list of all the exams you passed and the corresponding grades, credits (if they are adopted) or weekly/yearly hours for all teaching-learning activities (theory and practice), syllabi of the individual subject courses. This official certificate may be provided in English, French, Spanish, or Italian. If not, it must be officially translated. Alternatively, if available, a "diploma supplement" may be provided.

Given that the program is taught in English, you do not need to provide any certificate proving your competence in Italian, neither to pass the Italian competence exam once in Italy. However,
