4. official certificate issued by the foreign academic institution with the list of all the exams you passed and the corresponding grades, credits (if they are adopted) **in every year**, hours for all teaching-learning activities (theory and practice), syllabi of the individual subject courses. This official certificate may be provided in English, French, Spanish or other languages, not, it must be officially translated. Alternatively, if available, a **diploma supplement** may be provided.

Given that the program is taught in English, you do not need to provide any certificate proving your competence in Italian, neither to pass the Italian competence exam.
